UKCA marking manufacturers' checklist

Identify the possible intended uses of your adhesive/sealant/membrane/screed

HIN ¹	Download the consolidated list to excel so you can search by a term to find applicable standards	
HIN	Also check the scope of the designated standard	
	esignated standard exists, you must use this to affix UKCA marking before you place your product e GB market	
3.	In Annex ZA of the designated standard, identify the list of essential characteristics and the AVCP system for each of them if they are different	
HIN	The same essential characteristic may be under a different system depending on the intended use.	
4.	Check that there are no GB building regulations giving specific minimum performance requirements	
ADVICE	Develop your own list of characteristics to declare

	9.	Draw up the instructions and safety information for the product				
	10.	Check if any substances in the product are included in the scope of the <u>UK REACH regulation</u> and complete the tasks to fulfil its requirements.				
	HIN'	BASA Guide to UK REACH is available to explain how UK REACH affects most BASA Member companies				
	11.	Store the background documents and a copy of the declaration of performance for 10 years from the last time this kind of product was sold.				
	12.	Place the product on the market together with the required documents				
	13.	Continue the tasks relating to the assessment and verification of constancy (AVCP) of the declared performance (factory production control and testing).				
	14.	If the performance, the raw materials or the manufacturing processes change, or the designated standard is significantly revised then go back to point 5.				

NOTE: IMPORTANT DEFINITIONS (UK CPR article 2.16 and 2.17)

Regularly check the list of <u>designated standards</u> to verify whether the standards have been updated

'Making available on the market' means any supply of a construction product for distribution or use on the market of Great Britain in the course of a commercial activity, whether in return for payment or free of charge

'Placing on the market' means

The first making available of a construction product on the market of Great Britain.

Each batch of sealant or adhesive is placed on the market individually.
