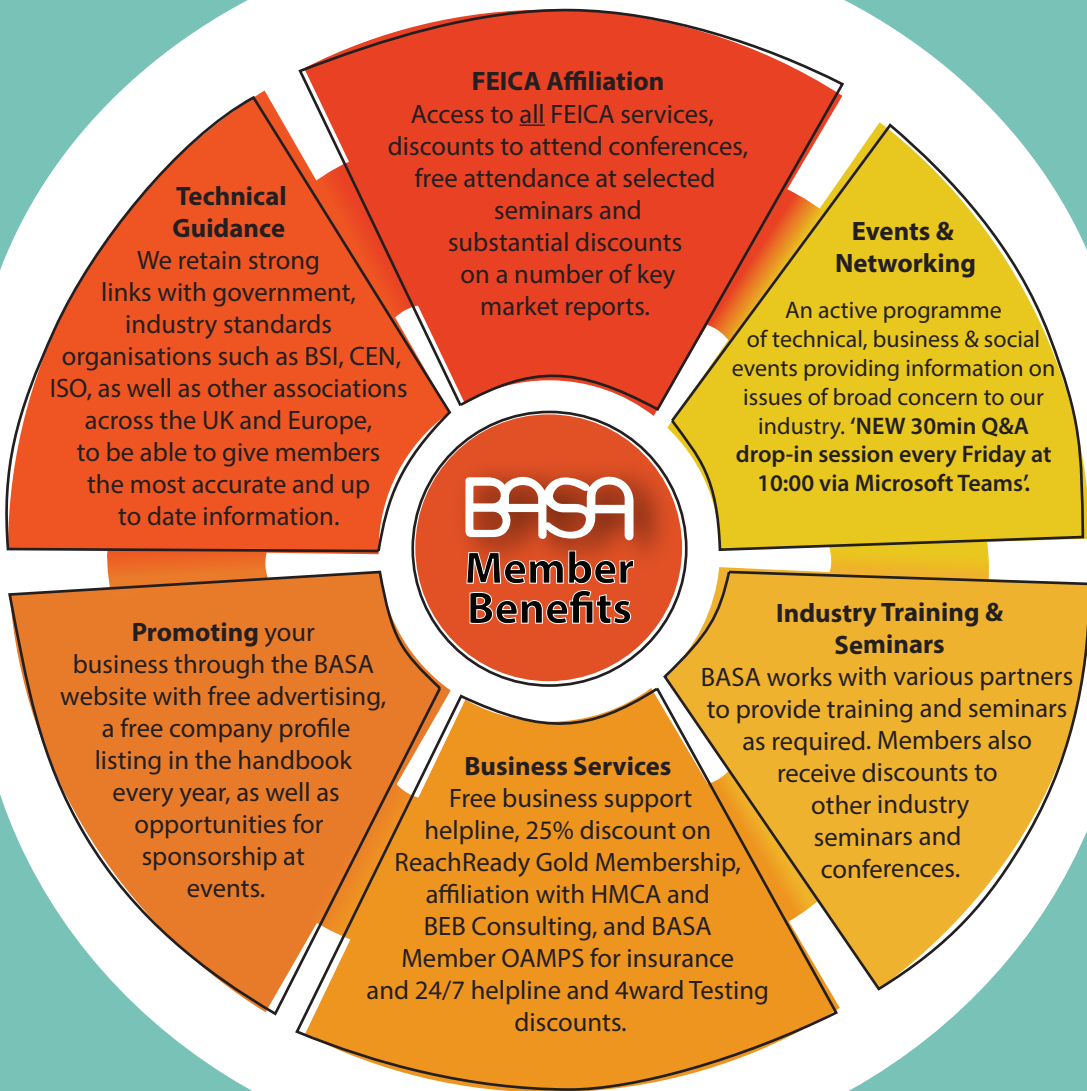

# Networking & Workshop Events Programme

Unfortunately all physical BASA Events are currently on hold due to the Covid-19 Pandemic. We hope that the latest advances in management of the pandemic will allow us to be able to get together for at least one event in 2021. In the meantime as a reminder of what we can look forward to:

**Annual Industry Lunch** – Usually held in March each year, an excellent opportunity for senior managers to get together, in the past we have held the event at a variety of venues including JaguarLandrover in Castle Bromwich, Twickenham, Leicester Racecourse, the National Space Centre, Edgbaston, Williams F1 Centre and the Silverstone racing track. This is the perfect Networking opportunity, the lunch is combined with a selection of speakers to provide the maximum opportunity for Members to hear about the topics impacting the industry. Our hope is to hold the 2022 event at the SS Great Britain, the venue for the postponed 2020 event.

**BASA Sports Day** - We hope that the combined golf and shooting day held each year in June and free croquet game before the sumptuous three-course dinner can return to BASA's event schedule soon; we will make a decision regarding the 2021 event in Q1 2021. The combined event is held in Shropshire at Hawkstone Park and the nearby West Midlands Shooting Ground. This is a more casual opportunity to talk to colleagues in the Sector and to Network during a less formal event.

**BASA Dinner Dance** - Held on a Saturday evening at the end of November each year and over the years we have held the event in Oxford, Cheltenham, Harrogate, Leeds, Windsor, Birmingham, Manchester, Stratford-upon-Avon and Chester. The black tie event is open to Members and guests of Members and is a hugely popular event at the end of the year. We would hope that the November 2021 event can go ahead as planned after the cancellation of the 2020 event at Stratford-upon-Avon.

**Open Industry Forum** - We hold at least two OIF's each year, free to Members and are arranged around topical speakers to advise Members of the current technical and business issues that may affect them. This is one of the tools we use to communicate information to Members, in conjunction with the excellent Members-only area of the website. We will continue to hold the OIF by webinar, and the first virtual event in November 2020 had over 50 participants and excellent speakers from government talking about the upcoming UK chemicals and product regulations. We would hope to hold the next webinar in Q1 2021.

**Workshops and Training Seminars** - We try to hold a variety of these each year and have recently added some free webinars to the portfolio. We are able to deliver information and guidance to a smaller number of Members in face-to-face workshops that usually attract a modest charge, or larger groups via free-to-members webinars. We actively encourage Members to propose topics that they wish to know more about so that we can add this to our programme. We are an Association for Members and we want to give all Members access to the information they need to run their business and all webinars are currently being offered to Members free of charge for the foreseeable future. In addition we have added a FREE 30 minute Q&A Clinic every Friday at 10:00 with access to BASAs Constants to answer all your technical and regulatory concerns. We may not have the immediate answer but we will get the answer for you from our extensive contact network.

**FEICA Events** - as National Association members of FEICA, the European Adhesives & Sealants Association, all BASA Member Companies have discounted access to the annual FEICA Conference and free attendance at selected seminars during the year. FEICA is an association for all European Manufacturers and our membership is unaffected by Brexit – so we are able to keep up to date with all the EU regulatory changes for BASA Members with business in Europe and also to still be able to be involved in discussions through FEICA.
